What animal is an orangutan?

t the Nyaru Menteng Forest School in Borneo, Indonesia, there are 600 orangutans. They are in classes of 8-12 students. The orangutans have lessons with human teachers. They teach them how to climb trees, how to make a nest\*, how to open nuts – and that snakes are dangerous! In the wild, baby orangutans stay with their mother until they are eight years old. So why are orangutans going to school? Why aren't they living in the rainforest?

It's because the rainforest is getting smaller. Companies\* are

The orangutans' home is cut down for palm oil plants.

> cutting down trees to plant palm oil plants [See box] and the orangutans don't have enough food or places to stay. The mother orangutans leave the rainforest to look for food and trees - and are often killed.

The teachers at Forest School rescue\* the babies. They teach them to survive in the rainforest. It's cute, but it's sad too.
