

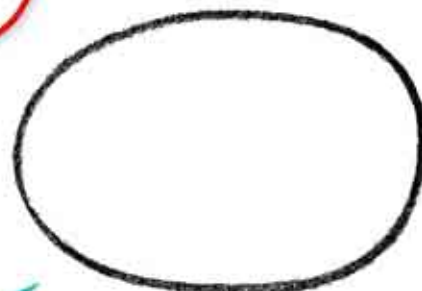

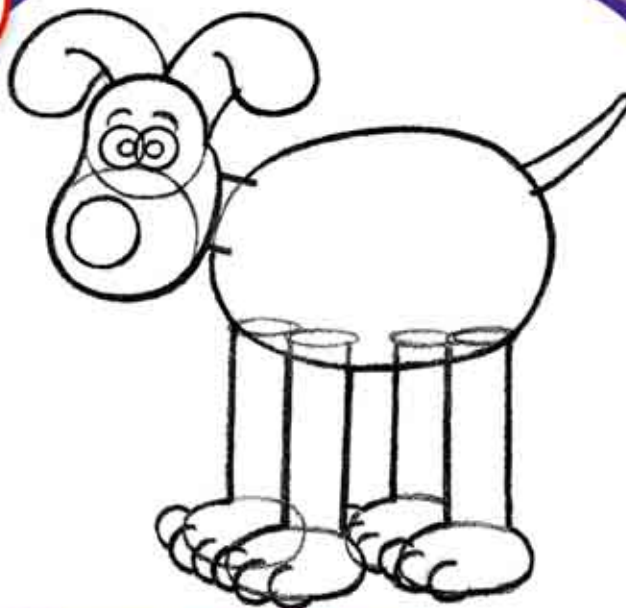
# GROMIT!

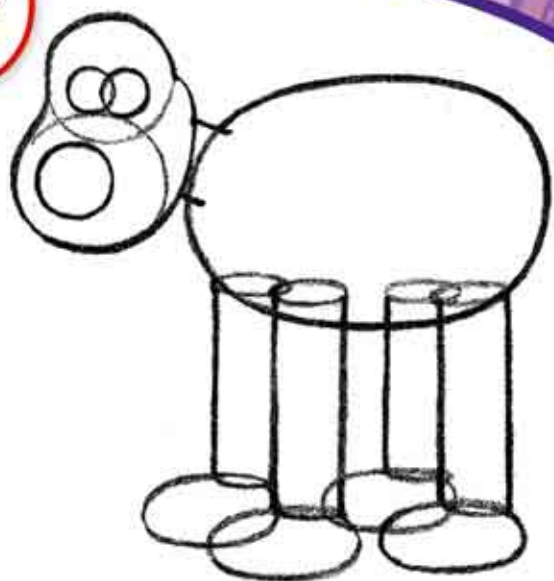
Where would Wallace be without Gromit? Probably in a right mess, surrounded by smouldering rubble! This is your chance to draw an unswervingly loyal canine of your very own!

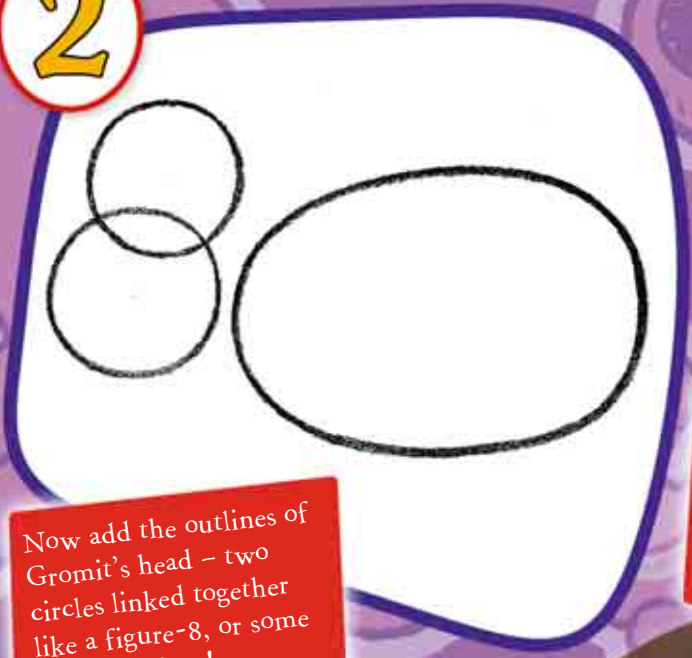
Gromit's got his personality at last! This is the stage to add in details such as his ears, pupils, eyebrows, toes and tail. Take time to note the way his ears fold differently, depending on which side of his head they're on. Gromit has three toes on each foot!

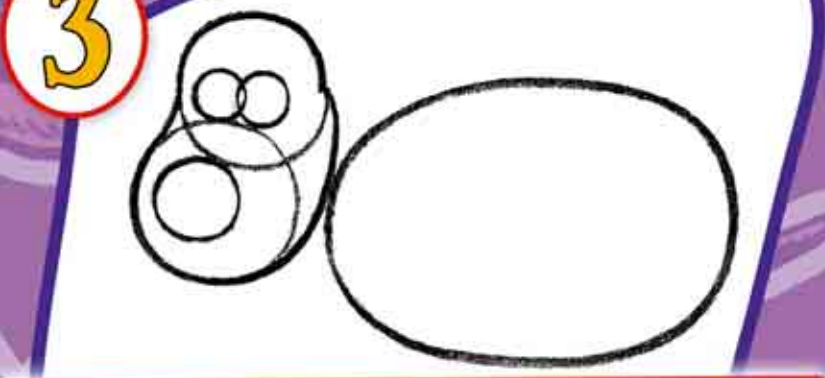
Now let's add Gromit's legs and feet – his legs are long tubes, and his feet are squashed oval shapes. You can attach his head to his body with a short neck here, too!

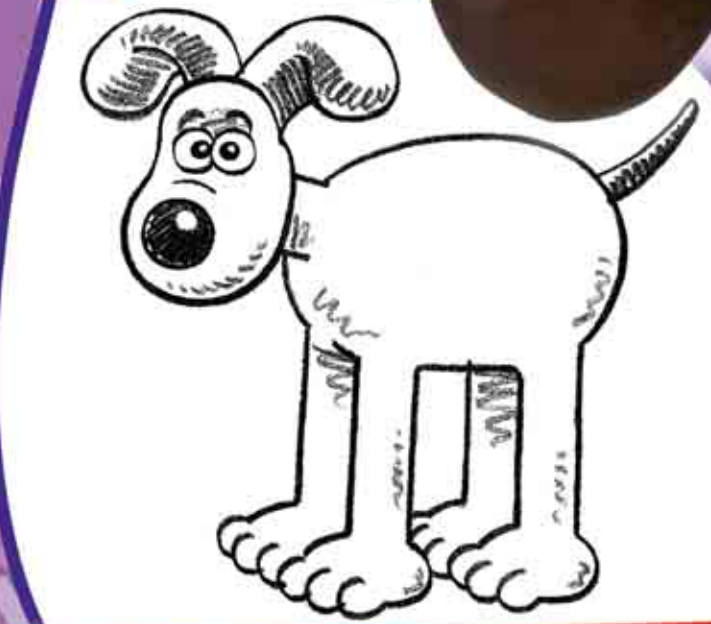
Now add the outlines of Gromit's head – two circles linked together like a figure-8, or some Olympic rings!

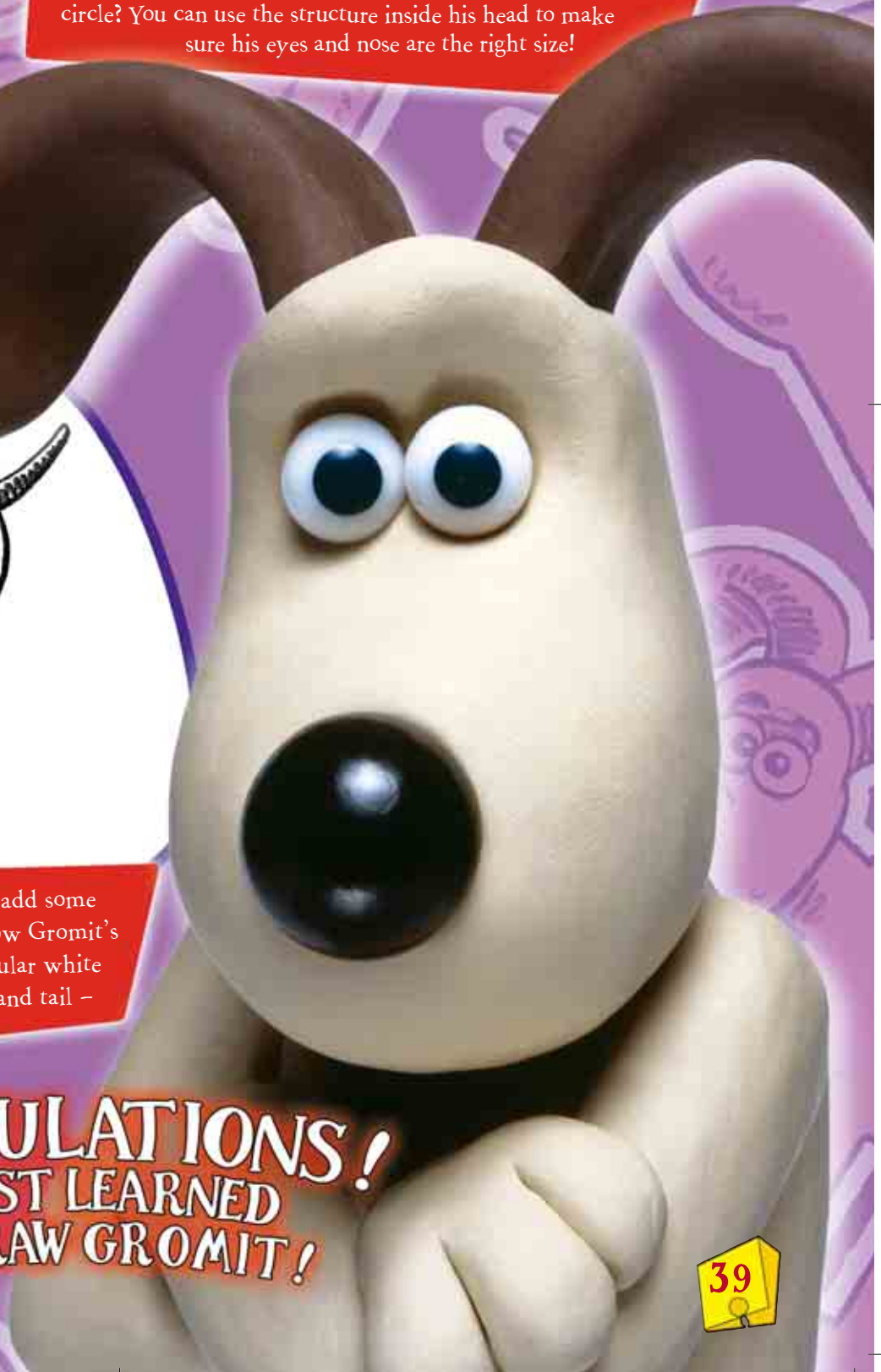


Form the outline of the head around these circles. Add Gromit's nose and eyes, here, too – remember that the eye that is closest to you will overlap the one behind it slightly. Did you notice that Gromit's nose butts up against the bottom of the uppermost circle? You can use the structure inside his head to make sure his eyes and nose are the right size!

The final stage is to erase all the guidelines, and add some shading to your finished picture! Can you see how Gromit's eyes and nose are mostly black, except for a circular white highlight? Add some shadows on his ears, body and tail – and you're done!
