You're **Marie Curie** (1867–1934)

You're **Ada Lovelace** (1815–1852)

You are the world's first computer programmer. You worked with Charles Babbage on his early computer, but you had much more vision than all the men. Your father was the famous poet. Lord Byron. The computer language 'Ada' is named after you. You are very well off, and marry an Earl.



You're Rosalind Franklin (1920–1958)

You are the British chemist who was involved in the discovery of the structure of DNA. You should have won a Nobel Prize, but you died young and the men hogged the limelight.



You're Albert Einstein (1879–1955)
