




Challenge 2: Read a fantasy book that's out of this world

- **Create your own rocket using a tube of kitchen or toilet roll, some glue, scissors and paper.**

1. Cover the cardboard tube roll in paper.
2. For the top of the rocket, draw around a small, circular object, such as a cup. Cut out the circle, then cut a line from the outside to the middle of the circle. Slide one edge over the other until it is a cone shape. Stick it to stay in this shape, then stick it to the top of the tube.
3. Finally, add decorations to your rocket! What colour is it? Does it have any windows to see inside? Add some streamers to the bottom as the fire that propels it into space.



- **Design your own imaginary creature. Do they come from space, or another world? Do they have wings, fur or feathers? What noises do they make? Do they have special powers? Make sure you give them a name!**
- **Imagine what it would be like to be an astronaut and write a story about a trip to the moon. Tell us about your journey there, what it was like when you got there and how you got home again.**
