

Make a Dreidl

Make your own *dreidl* and play it at home.

You will need:

- piece of tracing paper (or baking paper)
- pen
- piece of thick card or thin cardboard (such as a used cereal box)
- coloured felt-tip pens
- scissors
- tape
- pencil

Instructions:

1. Trace the outline of the template on the opposite page onto tracing paper. Make sure to include the dotted lines!
2. Turn the tracing paper over and place it on your card. Draw over the lines you traced, pressing down heavily so that the drawing transfers onto your card.
3. Copy the Hebrew letters from the template onto your piece of card and decorate it now, if you want to.

SAFETY FIRST

Ask an adult for help when using scissors.

4. Carefully cut around the template. Don't cut the dotted lines. Fold the dotted lines. Press hard to make strong folds.
5. Tape the card together. Leave a small hole at the top.
6. Push a pencil point through the top of the *dreidl* to make a handle. Turn the page to find out how to play!
