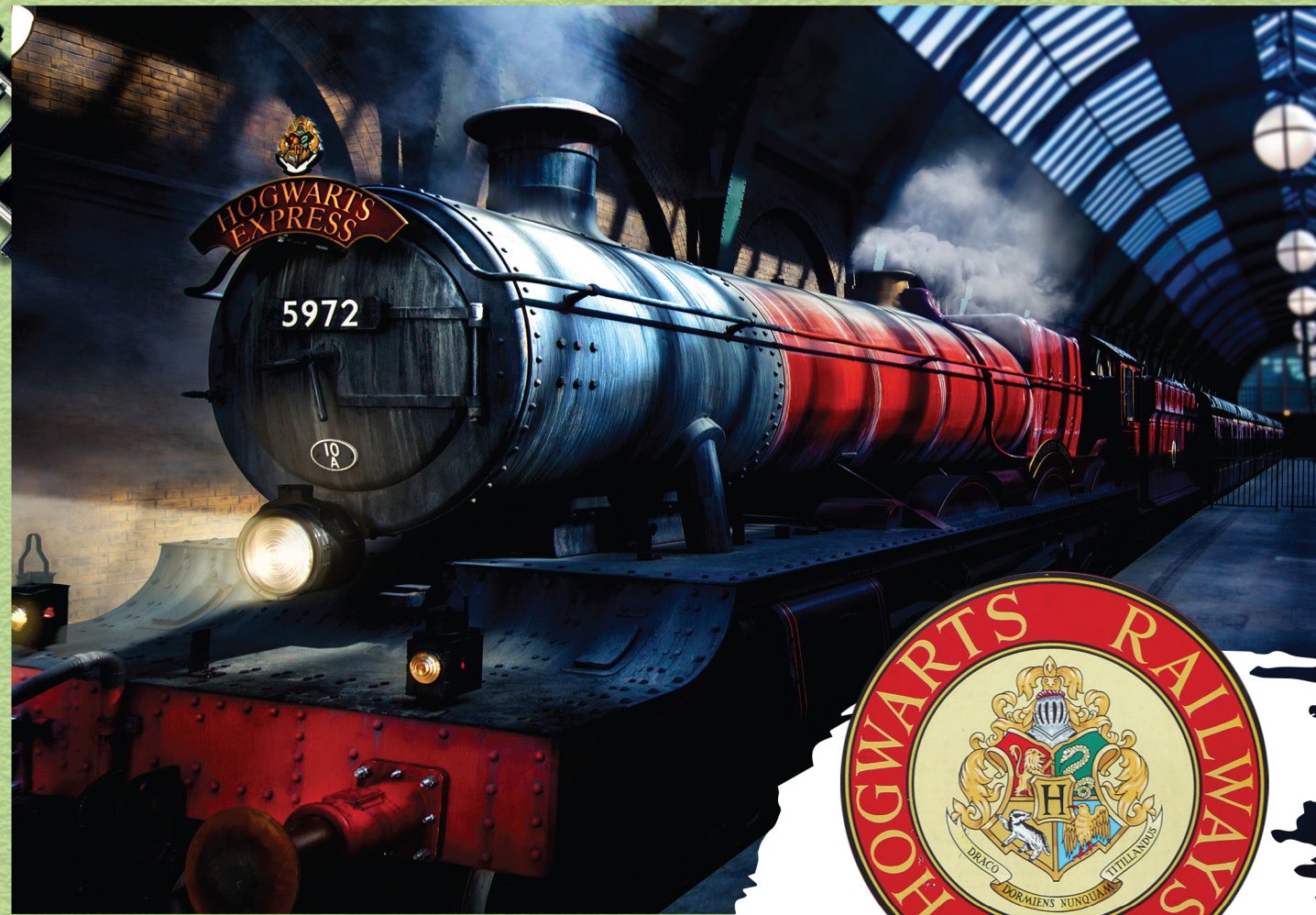
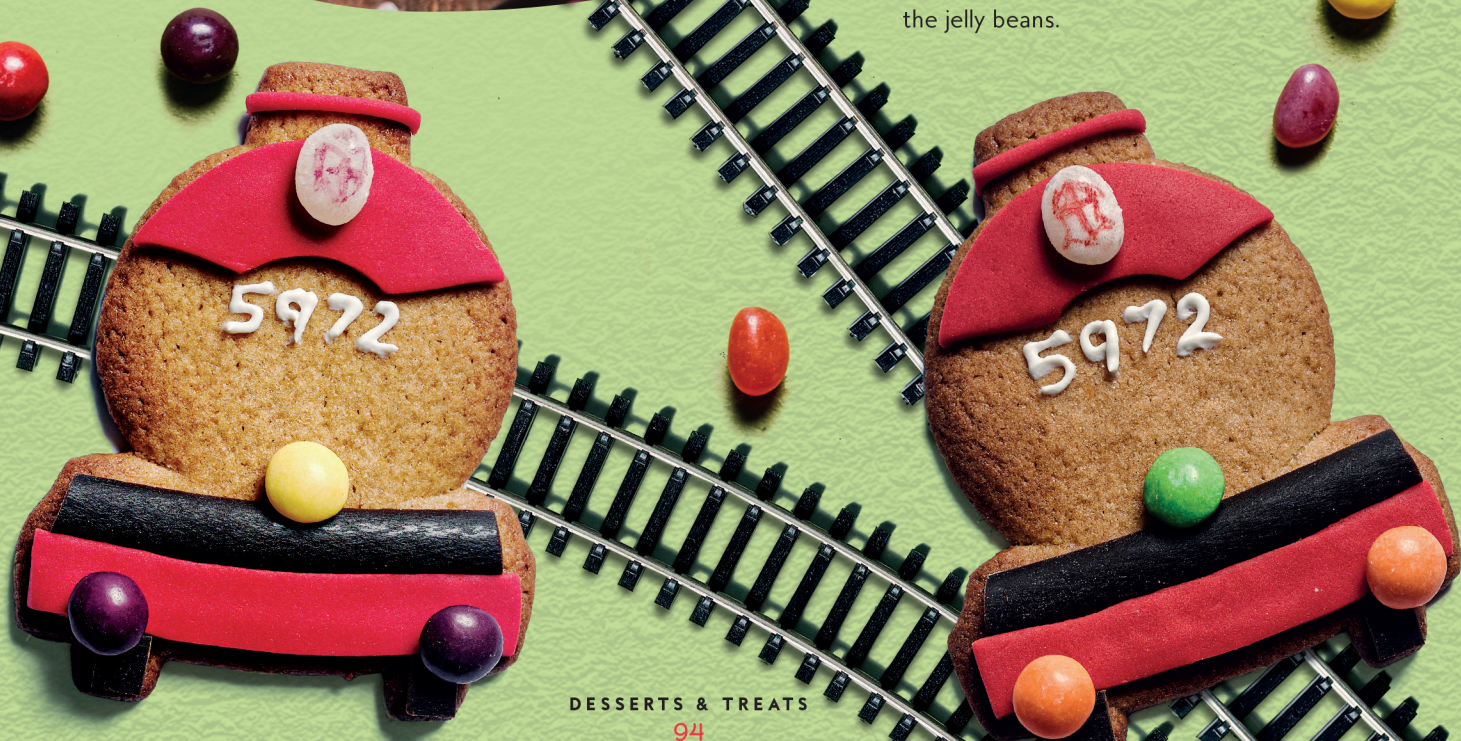




- 4 Trace and cut out the red plate template on page 120. Thinly roll out the red fondant on a surface lightly dusted with confectioners' sugar. Lay the template on top and cut around it with a small sharp knife. Squeeze a little decorator frosting at the top of a train cookie (this will act as glue), and position the red fondant. Cut out a 3 x 1/2 inch/7.5 x 1 cm rectangle and secure along the base of the train in the same way. Cut out and position more shapes on the remaining cookies. Secure thin strips of red fondant trimmings around the funnels.
- 5 Using a small sharp knife, cut the licorice into thin strips and position next to the red fondant. Cut smaller pieces to cover the wheels. Again, use the decorator frosting to secure in place.
- 6 Pipe "5972" onto the front of the cookies and then secure the colored candies and jelly beans in place using more decorator frosting. Use the cake pen to draw the Hogwarts crest onto the jelly beans.



MAGICAL FACT

The Hogwarts Express is made of real steam train parts: the locomotive "5972 Olton Hall" and four (later five) British Railways Mark I passenger carriages.
